## What is aquatics camp?

A weeklong program offering ALL the BSA Aquatics awards and certifications and have fun doing it.

This is an opportunity for ALL Boy Scouts, Venturers, and Sea Scouts to enjoy the adventure and fun of camping at Ten Mile River and take part in a full menu of Aquatic activities.

This includes all the Scout Aquatic rank advancement, Core requirements for Bronze, Gold and Silver awards. If you are working on Quest or Ranger, you can also complete these core elements and Red Cross certifications for your programs. Sea Scouts will have the opportunity to sail, work on small boat handler's bar, handle motor boats, and acquire all the aquatics skills for Apprentice, Ordinary, Able and Quartermaster.

The program includes a Voyageur canoe experience, BBQ and awards ceremony. Candidates for "Kayaking, BSA" and Whitewater merit badge, will have a full day on the Delaware River to complete the award. All certificates and patches earned are awarded at closing ceremonies.
